



CAREFREE COVID19 UPDATE – June 23, 2021

The Board continues to monitor the COVID-19 decreases along with Vaccine rollout within the province as they contribute to our decision-making process. 6-foot social distancing continues to apply to all residents and visitors along with masks where required. Resort management and staff have implemented many necessary precautionary measures. It is the responsibility of all residents and guests to self-monitor your distancing compliance.

Stage 3 of Alberta's Open for Summer Plan – Reopening starting July 1, 2021.

- All restrictions lifted, including ban on indoor social gatherings **(Note, this is not in effect yet)**

Vaccination data are up-to-date as of end of day June 22, 2021

- **3,903,238** doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been administered in Alberta
- **71 percent** of 12+ population has received at least one dose (**60.5%** total population)
- **31.5 percent** of 12+ population fully vaccinated (**26.9%** total population)

AHS PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES- Stage 2 (Alberta currently in Stage 2)

Stage 2: Two weeks after 60% of Albertans 12+ (born in 2009 or earlier) have received at least one dose, and hospitalizations are below 500 and declining. Took effect June 10.

- Outdoor social gatherings – up to 20 people with distancing (indoor social gatherings still not permitted)
- Indoor recreation, entertainment and other settings (rec centres, arenas, casinos, cinemas, theatres, museums, galleries, libraries, etc.) – open at 1/3 of fire code occupancy
- Gyms and fitness studios – open for solo and drop-in activities and indoor fitness classes with 3 metre distancing
- Funeral services – up to 20 people, indoors and outdoors (receptions permitted outdoors only)
- Wedding ceremonies – up to 20 people, indoors and outdoors (receptions permitted outdoors only)
- Places of worship – 1/3 of fire code occupancy
- Personal and wellness services – resume walk-in service
- Post-secondary – resume in-person learning
- Restaurants – 6 people per table max, indoors or outdoors
- Retail – 1/3 of fire code occupancy (must maintain ability to distance)
- Youth activities (day camps, overnight camps, play centres) – resume with restrictions
- Youth and adult sports – resume with no restrictions, indoors and outdoors
- Outdoor public gatherings (concerts/festivals) – up to 150 people
- Outdoor fixed seating facilities (grandstands) – 1/3 seated capacity
- Work from home order is lifted but still recommended
- Distancing and masking requirements remain in effect

Stage 3 of “Alberta’s Open for Summer Plan” will allow us to again hold Social events!!!

CAREFREE OFFICE-OPEN

The office is open with appropriate shielding for staff and visitors. Access is limited to one visitor at a time. Email or call the office in advance is still preferred. We want to thank everyone for your cooperation and understanding.

POOL-OPEN

Some Restrictions are in place, Chairs and Loungers may not be moved and social distancing is in effect. The pool will be closed during cleaning, approximately 30 min twice a day

SCOOPS STORE-OPEN

Open with some restrictions. Thank you for your respectful distancing while waiting in line for the ice cream!

WASH HOUSE LAUNDRY-OPEN

Wash house laundry will be open between the hours of 6:00am to 11:00pm. Access cards are required for entry.

CLUBHOUSE WASHROOMS/SHOWERS/LAUNDRY-OPEN

Clubhouse washrooms and showers will be open from 6:00am to 11:00pm. Access cards are required for entry. Full cleaning will take place in the morning and at the end of the business day, there will be no access to these facilities during cleaning. Sanitizing wipes will be available and we ask Owners and Guests to please clean before and after use. Masks are required in the Clubhouse.

Clubhouse Laundry room is open: No access card required from 8:30am to 5:00pm, access card is required for entry from 5:00pm to 8:30am. Masks are required in the Clubhouse laundry.

PLAYGROUNDS - IMPORTANT: NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Use of the playground structures is solely at the discretion of parent/guardians. It is recommended that hands are washed prior to using playground structures as well as immediately after. Please allow for social distancing or sharing access time of the structures with other families.

We strongly request that if you are showing any symptoms that you notify the Carefree office and return to your primary residence immediately, as rural health services are not equipped to handle an outbreak.
