The Board continues to monitor the COVID-19 cases increases/decreases along with Vaccine rollout within the province as they contribute to our decision-making process. 6-foot social distancing continues to apply to all residents and visitors along with masks where required. Resort management and staff have implemented many necessary precautionary measures. It is the responsibility of all residents and guests to self-monitor your distancing compliance. Vaccination data are up-to-date as of end of day May 24, 2021

- **2,552,317** doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been administered in Alberta
- **49.2** percent of population has received at least one dose
- **7.9** percent of population fully vaccinated

AHS PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES

- **Outdoor gatherings** have attendance limits depending on active cases in your area.
High case area restriction
 - 5 people maximum (2 household cohorts maximum is encouraged)**Additional safety measures for all areas**
 - Mandatory physical distancing must be maintained at all times between members of different households.
 - Outdoor gatherings must not have an indoor component (movement in/out of homes is not permitted).
- **All indoor gatherings** are prohibited – public and private (Province wide Restriction)
 - close contacts are limited to household members only
 - people who live alone can have up to 2 close contacts:
 - these must be the same two contacts throughout the duration of the restriction
 - if the close contacts do not live alone, visits cannot be held at their home
 - single parents who only live with their children under 18 can have up to 2 close contacts

SOCIAL EVENTS

In the near term we are unable to offer any large group-type social events. As the Vaccine rollout progresses and case counts decrease we are hopeful restrictions may ease into the summer. We will continue to monitor AHS advice and we will adjust accordingly.

CAREFREE OFFICE-OPEN

The office is open with appropriate shielding for staff and visitors. Access is limited to one visitor at a time. Email or call the office in advance is still preferred. We want to thank everyone for your cooperation and understanding.

POOL-CLOSED

Due to AHS restrictions and the number of people who use or pool, we are unable to open the pool at this time. We will continue to work with our AHS representative and will update owners as we receive the information

SCOOPS STORE-OPEN

Open with some restrictions. Thank you for your respectful distancing while waiting in line for the ice cream!

WASH HOUSE LAUNDRY-OPEN

Open with some restrictions. Please contact the office to reserve a timeslot for use (2 hr usage). We must allocate 30 minutes for cleaning after each use. We encourage lot owners to take laundry home when possible.

CLUBHOUSE WASHROOMS/SHOWERS/LAUNDRY-CLOSED

The resort cannot adequately meet all AHS distancing and cleaning requirements for this high use area. As the province recommends the use of individual residences the Board deems these services non-essential and will remain closed.

VISITORS - CAUTION

We respectfully request that you ensure visitors do not display any symptoms and/or have been tested prior to entering the resort. We trust our residents will apply good judgement when inviting non-residents to the resort. Please ask your visitors to apply 6-foot social distancing with others within the resort.

PLAYGROUNDS - IMPORTANT: NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

Use of the playground structures is solely at the discretion of parent/guardians. It is recommended that hands are washed prior to using playground structures as well as immediately after. Please allow for social distancing or sharing access time of the structures with other families.

PREVENT THE SPREAD

We strongly request that if you are showing any symptoms that you notify the Carefree office and return to your primary residence immediately, as rural health services are not equipped to handle an outbreak.
